



OVERVIEW: Competitive Sealed Bidding Procurement Method

This is the method of procurement used most frequently. The Invitation for Bids (IFB) is the solicitation document.				
Determination For Use	Method of procurement to be used unless it is not feasible.			
Basis for Award	Lowest responsive, responsible bidder.			
Brief Description of Procedure	An invitation for bid is prepared including specifications for the goods, services or construction, and administrative requirements, provisions, etc. Public notice is issued inviting offerors to submit bids by a specified submittal date.			
Monetary Cap	In accordance with the contract.			
Term Limit of Contract	In accordance with the contract.			
Public Notice of Solicitation	Required. Shall be posted for a minimum of 10 days between the solicitation release date and bid submittal due date (a total of 12 days). Notices shall include brief description of goods, services or construction, due date for bid submittals, where and when solicitation may be obtained, contact information, pre-bid conference information and any other information as applicable. • HIEPRO solicitations: When a solicitation is conducted on HIEPRO, procurement notice of solicitation is automatically posted. • For solicitations not conducted on HIEPRO, the notice shall be posted manually to procurement notices of solicitations website (Executive branch).			
	Reference: HAR Sections 3-122-16.02, 3-12-16.03			
Public Notice of Award	Required . Must be posted to <u>contract awards website</u> (Executive branch) within 7 calendar days of award. Exception: HIePRO awards are automatically posted.			
Protests	Allowed for any phase of solicitation and award. • Protest of any phase of solicitation: shall be submitted in writing prior to receipt of offers. (HAR Section 3-126-3) • Protest of an award: shall be submitted in writing within 5 working days of posting of award. (HAR Section 3-126-4) • Stay of Procurement: Once filed, no further action shall be taken on the procurement until the protest has been settled. (HAR Section 3-




Hawaii Awards & Notices Data System (HANDS) "Use HANDS to Search for Bidding Opportunities"

OFFER DEEMED FIRM/AUTHORITY TO SUBMIT OFFER: Submission of an electronic response to the State of Hawaii constitutes and shall be deemed an offer to sell the specified goods and/or services to the State of Hawaii at the price shown in the response and under the State's Terms and Conditions. The electronic response submitter certifies that he/she is authorized to sign the response for the submitting vendor and that the response is made without connection with any person, firm, or corporation making a response for the same goods and/or services and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud.

COMPLIANCE AND DOCUMENTATION: Vendors are required to be compliant with all appropriate state and federal statutes. Proof of compliance is required through HCE or via paper documentation.





- Click on 'Start a new Registration' and complete the questionnaire
- Review data and electronically sign the application to certify
- Follow payment processing on-screen instructions
- View, print, and submit IRS 8821 form

What is Hawaii Compliance Express?

Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE) is an electronic system that provides vendors, contractors and service providers doing business with state or county agencies to quickly and easily document that they are compliant with applicable laws. HCE expedites your ability to furnish proof of compliance with the requirements of 103D-310(c), HRS.

This single certificate eliminates the need to obtain individual copies of clearances with the following agencies:

- · Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Form 8821
- · Department of Labor & Industrial Relations (DLIR) Form LIR27
- Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA) Form COGS
- . Department of Taxation (DOTAX) Form A-6

Under Hawaii law, you must provide proof of compliance in order to receive a contract worth \$2,500 or more with state and county government entities in Hawaii.
